<u>Intro:</u> G (4x) <u>VERSE I</u>

G (16x)

I hear the train a comin' it's rolling round the bend

And I ain't see the sunshine since I don't know when **C (8x)** G (8x) I'm stuck in Folsom Prison, and time keeps draggin' on **D7 (8x)** G (4x) But that train keeps a rollin' on down to San Antone **VERSE II** G (16x) When I was just a baby, my mama told me "Son, always be a good boy, don't ever play with guns" C (8x) G (8x) But I shot a man in Reno just to watch him die **D7 (8x)** G (4x) When I hear that whistle blowing, I hang my head and cry

VERSE III

G (16x)

I bet there's rich folks eating in a fancy dining car

They're probably drinking coffee and smoking big cigars **C (8x)** Well I know I had it coming, I know I can't be free **D7 (8x)** But those people keep a movin' and that's what tortures me

VERSE IV

G (16x)

If they freed me from this prison, if that railroad car was mine

I bet I'd move it on a little farther down the line
C (8x)
G (8x)
Far from Folsom Prison, that's where I want to stay
D7 (8x)
G (4x)
And I'd let that lonesome whistle blow my blues away
