

Let's Play Blues

Minor Blues | Key of A Easy Strum: D-D-U-U-D-U (12&,&4&) Advanced Strum: D-M-U-U-M-M

**Before you start, get your <u>chord chart</u> + <u>key chord</u> chart. **Play each numeral for a 4 count or 1x with D-M-U-U-M-M **Memorize this 12 bar form.

<u> 12 Bar Blues Formula</u>

Simplified form

- I IV I I
- IV IV I I
- V IV I V

With walk-down + turnaround

I - IV - I - I
IV - IV - I - I
V - bV- IV (Walk-Down)
I - IV - I - V (Turn Around)

12 Bar Blues | Key of A

- Am Dm Am Am
- Dm Dm Am Am
- Em Dm Am Em

With walk-down + turnaround

- Am Dm Am Am
- Dm Dm Am Am
- Em Ebm- Dm (Walk-Down)

Am - Dm - Am - Em (Turn Around)

Notes from Kevin:

- Practice this with easy chord shapes first. Refer to my <u>muting/chucking</u> tutorial for more on muted strums.
- Don't be afraid to play this progression 5-10x in a row. Build your confidence with the 12 bar form through lots of repetitions.
- Recommended metronome speeds 70, 80, 90.
- Try both first position and barre chords to challenge your chording hand.
